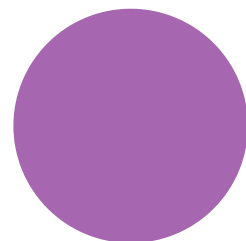

Percents(Election Day) Precincts



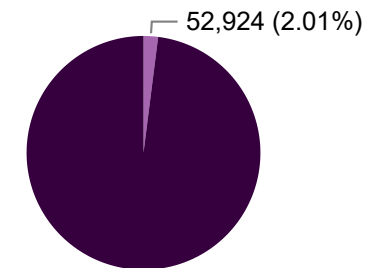

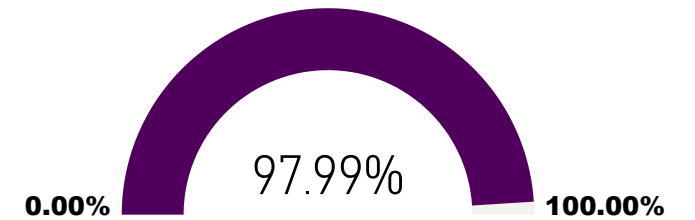
Total Absentee and Mail-In Ballots Cast, Counted, and Remaining to be Counted

Instead of voting in the polling places on Election Day, eligible voters had the option to request, receive and cast an absentee or mail-in ballot. Shown in the table below are absentee and mail ballot counts. The table shows the number of absentee and mail ballots issued to eligible voters, the number of these ballots cast and entered into SURE as of November 10, 2020 (this number will change as ballots received through the deadline are entered by counties), the number of and percentage of these ballots already counted, and numbers remaining to be counted, broken down by county.

County boards of elections in most cases will not finish counting mail and absentee ballots on election night, and ballots received through 8 PM on Election Day will be entered and reported after the earlier ballots received. Also, for the 2020 General Election, counties may continue to accept ballots that are postmarked by November 3, 2020 and received by mail through Friday, November 6, 2020. But these ballots will be kept separate from those received by 8 PM on November 3, 2020.

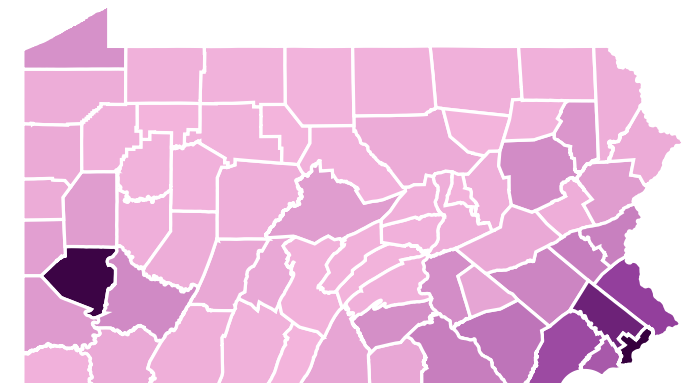

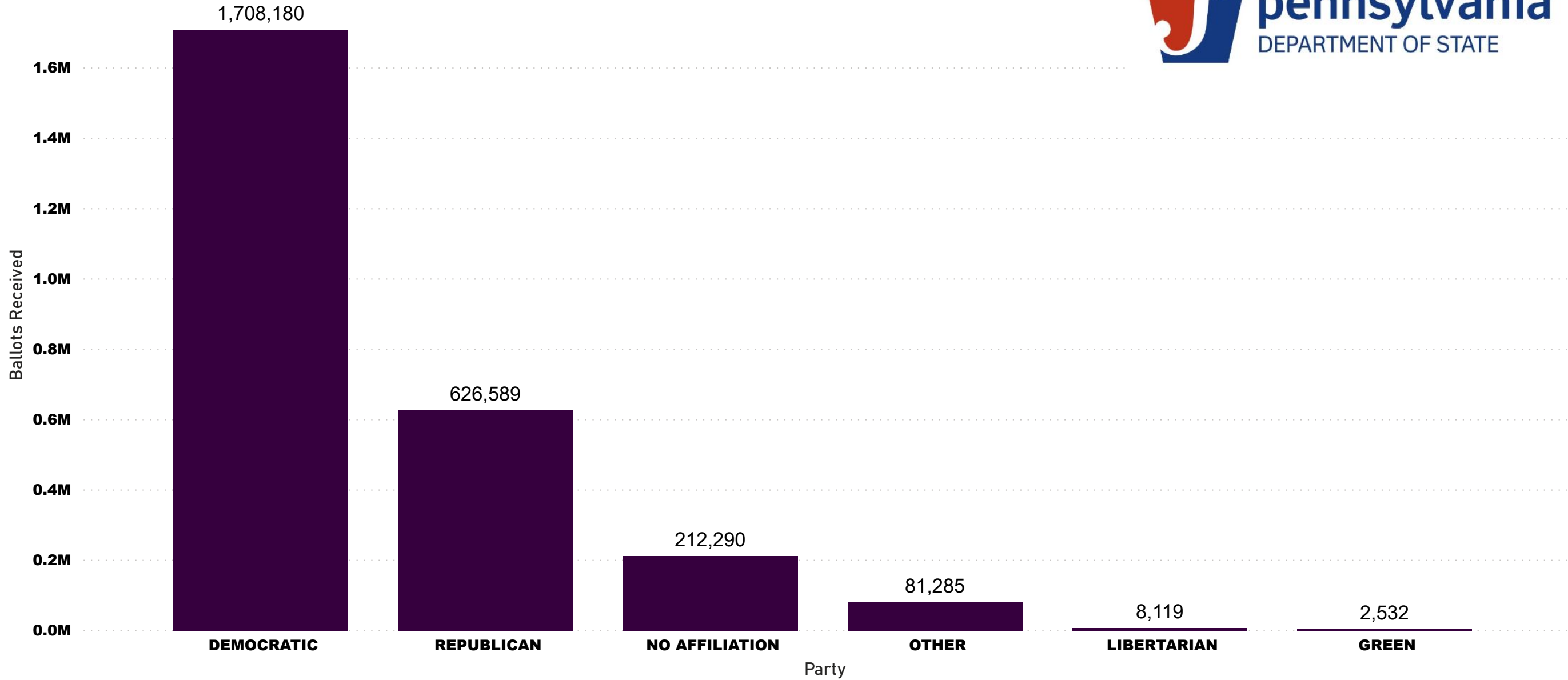

Mail-in and Absentee Ballots Cast, broken down by Party



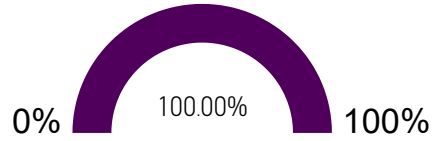
Precincts (Election Districts) Reporting

Election Day Regular Ballot votes only does NOT include absentee, mail-in, or provisional ballots

On Election Day, eligible voters cast their ballots in-person at the polling place for their "election district", commonly known as a precinct. The numbers below indicate the number of election districts participating in the election and the number of election districts whose in-person votes are currently reporting in contest totals. Contest totals will continue to change as additional election districts report their results.

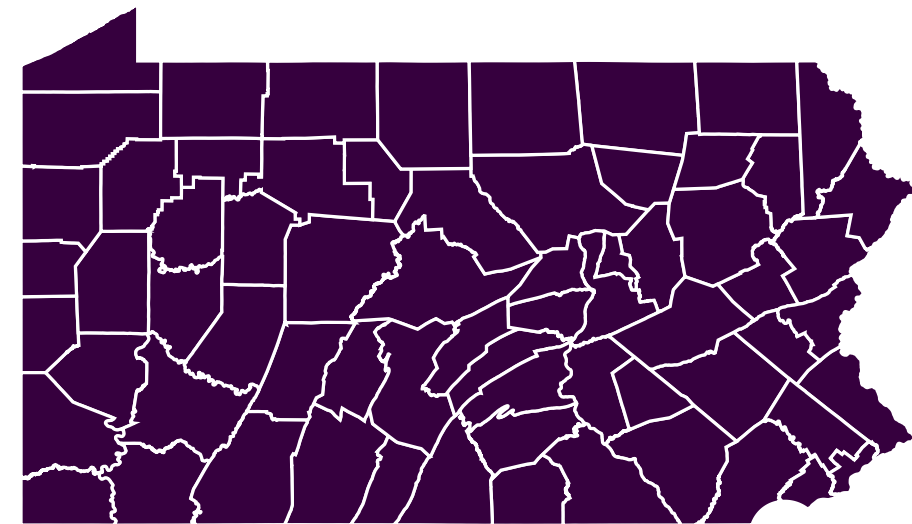

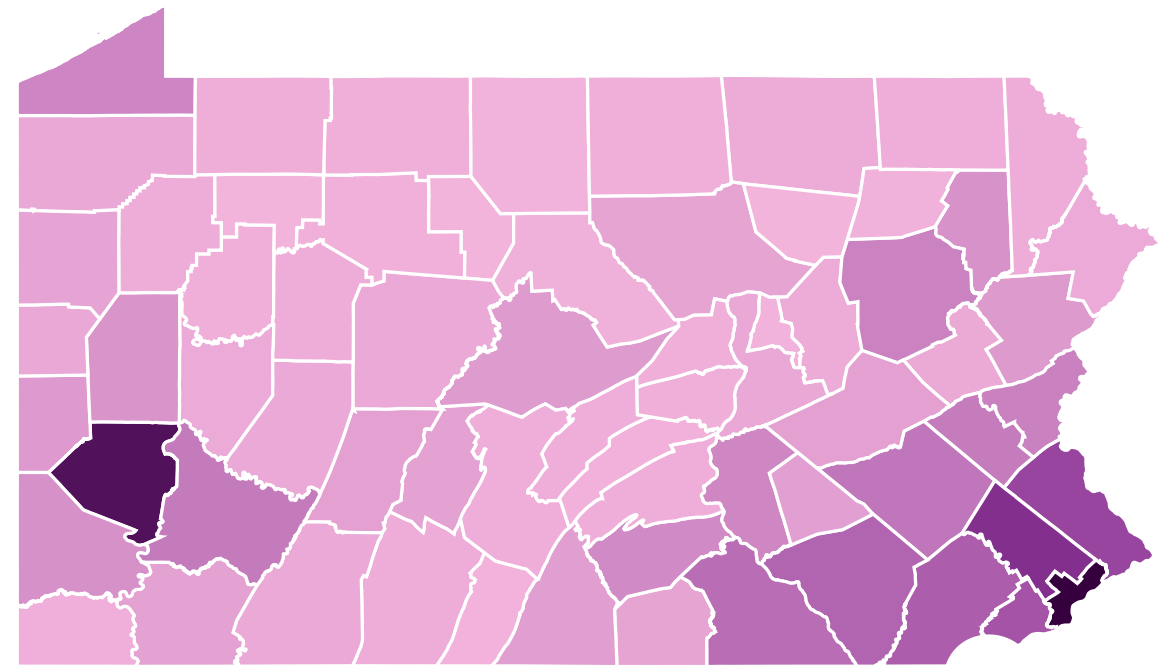

Provisional Ballots

On Election Day, if a voter is deemed not eligible to vote by regular ballot on the voting system , the voter may complete a Provisional application and cast a Provisional Ballot . The Provisional Ballot is sealed in a Provisional envelope .Provisional Applications are researched after election day and it is determined that the voter is eligible to vote in the election , their ballot will be approved for counting either in full or in part.



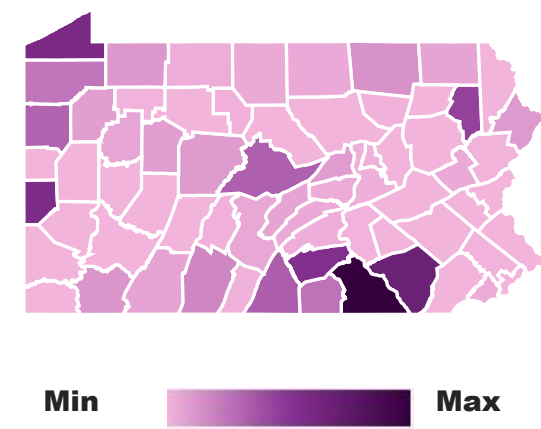

Glossary for Election Night Returns Dashboard

Ballots Sent - The number of absentee and mail-in ballots either mailed or delivered in person to voters.

Ballots Cast - The number of absentee and mail-in ballots returned by voters to a county to be counted.

Ballots Counted - The number of absentee and mail-in ballots that have been counted by the counties.

Ballots Remaining - The number of absentee and mail-in ballots that have not yet been counted by the counties (Ballots counted subtracted from Ballots cast).

Percentage Counted - Ballots counted as a Percentage of Ballots Cast (Ballots counted divided by Ballots Cast).
