






#### Total Absentee and Mail-In Ballots Cast and Percent Remaining to be Counted (1 of 3)









<u>Ballots Sent</u> - The number of absentee and mail-in ballots either mailed or delivered in person to voters.

Ballots Cast - The number of absentee and mail-in ballots returned by voters to a county to be counted.

<u>Ballots Counted</u> -The number of absentee and mail-in ballots that have been counted by the counties.

<u>Percentage Counted</u> - Ballots counted as a Percentage of Ballots Cast (Ballots counted divided by Ballots Cast).
